In the result of two or more qualified students, Director Betley will make the final decision. - 2) GPA must be a cumulative average of 3.0 or better (based on a 4.0 scale).
- 3) Be a child, step-child or grandchild of an association member in good standing
- 4) Submit a completed application and a 750 word essay describing future goal/s, including how the scholarship would assist in accomplishing this goal.
- 5) Three letters of recommendation from three different sources.
- 6) High school transcripts.
